Gracefully Broken

I was in one of those dollar stores last night. My kids are adults now and this woman and her two little children reminded me of myself decades ago. I was waiting in a long line and behind me was this woman and her two children. One of the kids looked like he was a Jr. High boy and the other a pre schooled aged little brother. The older boy had a pack of glow sticks he was eager to get out of the store with. The toddler's imagination as his big brother explained why he loved glow sticks, had stirred him up and he was soon screaming for his own glow sticks! The mom was exasperated and impulsively took the package of them from her older son and ripped open the package to give the temper-tantrum throwing youngster what he wanted and he quieted now. He was now walking around triumphantly but when the bigger boy took it back, the toddler started screaming again.

Just as the mom was about to repeat her pacifying strategy of giving the offended brother the glow stick back, the older child broke the membrane to allow the glowing liquid to activate the glow stick and then he handed it back to the toddler. As we walked outside at the same time, the toddler noticed that the stick was now glowing; and his brother explained his actions – "I had to break it so you could get the full effect from it!"

It was then that the Lord came up to me and He had my full attention. He spoke to me- "I had to break you to show you why I created you. You had to go through brokenness so you could fulfill the purpose I made you for." I knew exactly what heartbreaks He was talking about.

The little boy was happy just swinging the unbroken glow stick around in the air. He didn't understand what the stick was created to do- it was meant to glow.

There are some people who are content just to blend in. But God created us to show forth His light, His glow. We have to be broken to let release His glow.

We have to get sick.

We have to lose a job.

We go through a divorce.

We bury a spouse, our parents, a best friend or our very own child.

In those moments of desperation, God is breaking us. And as we align to His eternal purposes, we get a clearer vision for the reason He allows us to be broken.

The outward glow is the unexplainable peace that He gives to those who cling to the only Sure Thing that never fails- His love and faithfulness.
