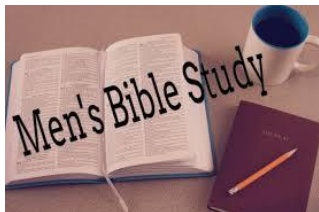

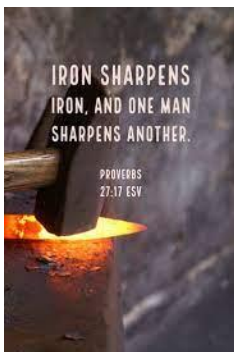

Mother's Day 2013

How do I say thank you for all the love and caring over the years? How do I repay all the nights you stayed up when I was sick and all the floors you walked when I was late coming home? What can I give you for all the times you supported me in my triumphs and provided a shoulder when there were losses? What present is there for all the times we sat together and shared our warmth?
