Called into Community: FELLOWSHIP

Mark 2:1-12

If ever there was a people person, it is God. He loves. He carries our burdens. He hears us. He's involved with us.

And He's made us with the same capacity and yearning.

Upon bringing us to life, He calls us into relationship not only with Himself but with others. To underscore the level of closeness, He borrows the language of permanency and intimacy, family. We are a family of believers. And as with all healthy families, we want to be close. Larry Crabb captures the longing,

The cry from your heart is your longing to be part of a true church, to participate in spiritual community, to engage in spiritual conversations of worship with God and of co-journeying with others. You yearn for a safe place, a community of friends who are hungry for God, who know what it means to sense the Spirit moving within them as they speak with you. In other words, you want to be loved unconditionally, to be who you really are without mask or pretense. You want to be able to admit failure and defeat without fear of being branded or judged but to be treated gently and with understanding. You long for people who can relate to where you're coming from. And who can offer a realistic and empathetic pathway to God and His healing.

That is called Christian fellowship. It is having a spiritual friend.

There are teaching texts on the subject but a gospel story both illustrates and teaches the same principles more memorably.

A Friend Knows and Enters into Your Heartache

¹When He had come back to Capemaum several days afterward, it was heard that He was at home. ²And many were gathered together, so that there was no longer room, not even near the door; and He was speaking the word to them. ³And they came, bringing to Him a paralytic, carried by four men.

A Friend Brings You to the Lord for Healing

⁴Being unable to get to Him because of the crowd, they removed the roof above Him; and when they had dug an opening, they le: down the pallet on which the paralytic was lying.

A Friend Rejoices with You

⁶And Jesus seeing their faith said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven."

⁶But some of the scribes were sitting there and reasoning in their hearts, ⁷"Why does this man speak that way? He is blaspheming; who can forgive sins but God alone?"

⁸Immediately Jesus, aware in His spirit that they were reasoning that way within themselves, said to them, "Why are you reasoning about these things in your hearts?

⁹"Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, "Your sins are forgiven"; or to say, 'Get up, and pick up your pallet and walk'?

¹⁰"But so that you may know

that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins"—He said to the paralytic, ¹¹"I say to you, get up, pick up your pallet and go home." ¹²And he got up and immediately picked up the pallet and went out in the sight of everyone, so that they were all amazed and were glorifying God, saying, "We have never seen anything like this."
