A word from Pastor Rick...

As we jump back into our normal activities and work, sometimes life can overwhelm us. But, at the end of Matthew chapter 11, Jesus is telling the Jewish people that he wants to give them rest. They were burdened down with the law and all the additions to it that the Pharisees had made. Jesus tells them "Come to me," they were weary and carrying heavy burdens and Jesus says, "give those to me". It's clear that true salvation is found only in a relationship with Christ. To come to him means to trust Him.

Then he tells the disciples to "take my yoke". Once we are in relationship with Jesus he asks us to yoke up with Him. It is the yoke of discipleship and it is "easy" meaning it fits well. He pulls through life with us. We can lean into Him when the going gets tough.

He tells us to learn from Him. Normally an experienced oxen would pull with a young immature oxen. The one was teaching the other how to pull, as we walk alongside of Him our trust grows. He brings peace and rest into our lives. What a wonderful relationship I can have with my Savior!
